- Conference dinner on Wednesday, 9 December

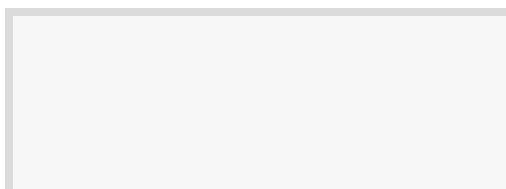
Various accommodation options are also available.
